Sustainability Policy Statement

Policy Aims

The aim of the sustainability policy is to provide guidelines for ethical purchase of pulp, paper and paper products used in production of paper tissue and distribution in a market which supports the environmental sustainability of all individuals on short term and long term.

Policy statement

Royal Musk Pty Ltd is committed to purchase forest products from legal, sustainably managed, non-controversial and suppliers with certification from recognised body. To keep the record on up-to-date basis, a due diligence assessment of all suppliers of forest products will be carried out on annually.

Royal Musk Pty Ltd will not be involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal logging, illegal harvesting or illegal trade of forest products.
- Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector.
- Violation of workers' rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO)
 Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or forest products
 sector.
- Destruction of High Conservation Values (HCVs) in forests or High Conservation Value areas.
- Conversion of natural forest cover.
- Use of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations for any other purposes than research.
